

Financial Literacy

Financial literacy education and standards will be incorporated into the school's curriculum.

Teachers of financial literacy at the school will reference the Financial Literacy Academic Content Standards as provided by the Ohio Department of Education.

Teachers will use the Ohio Department of Education's Sample Financial Literacy Syllabus as a guide in planning and implementing financial literacy education.

The principal of the school will ensure that students in the appropriate grade levels receive instruction in financial literacy as outlined by the Ohio Department of Education. The principal will review lesson plans as a part of this process. The principal will ensure that teachers can access applicable teaching resources regarding financial literacy information, including the resources provided on the Ohio Department of Education's website. Financial Literacy information will be presented at professional development meetings, staff meetings and/or teacher based team meetings.

As part of its financial literacy curriculum, the school supports and encourages community partnerships in financial literacy instruction, such as collaboration with local banks and presentations by guest speakers.
